## **RUISHTON AND THORNFALCON PARISH COUNCIL**

### **VILLAGE AGENT**

Village Agents work with all ages dealing with a wide variety of issues. Helping to solve these problems may, ultimately, help the elderly to remain living independently for longer. Village Agents also have the role of helping to shape services by feeding back to the appropriate body information about gaps in service e.g. transport provision. They can also motivate and support a community to respond to a local need by working together to address issues e.g. by helping them to set up a coffee morning for a group of lonely people or start a volunteer car scheme

Audrey Mansfield, the Village Agent for Ruishton & Thornfalcon parish has been on this post for 3 years. Her main role is to help with all ages dealing with a wide variety of issues, although a considerable number of their clients are elderly and involves social care issues and those who are isolated. Audrey outlined a few examples where she has helped parishioners in this parish.

### **20MPH SPEED LIMIT - UPDATE**

The Council has investigated the process for a 20mph scheme at Newlands Grove, Newlands Road, Newlands Crescent and Lawn Meadow as well as researching other measures. The process was for the County Councillor to lead the scheme and put it forward as a Small Improvements Scheme. County Councillor Ross Henley informed the Council that the first step for a 20mph zone would be a traffic survey to see how many cars were travelling over 20mph and he agreed to have this arranged.

The Chairman and Vice Chairman had a meeting with the School which was also attended by two PCSO's. The School's concern is the lack of parking which results in dangerous situation at the School's opening and closing times with parents trying to find a place to park especially when they have to use the reserve gear. There are 175 children at the school which 48% live outside the area.

Our current PCSO will be leaving Avon and Somerset Constabulary at the end of February after 10 years of service. PCSO 8466 Eamonn Leniston and PCSO 8412 Claire Escott will be covering this Beat. The Beat Manager will be PC2898 Dean Chedzoy

### **CHANGES IN THE BEAT TEAM FOR RUISHTON AND THORNFALCON**

#### **COUNTY COUNCILLOR'S REPORT**

County Councillor Ross Henley reported on the following at the February meeting:

- He visited the Mobile Library and met a number of parishioners. He hopes to keep promoting the service and to get the school involved.
- He is appalled on the state of some of the pavements in parts the village and he will keep onto Highways to repair.

Somerset County Council has increased the Council Tax by 5.24% for 2016/17 which is the highest in the country of any County Council. Part of this rise is for the River's Authority to pay for the costs of flooding in the Somerset Levels two years ago and to pay for the alleviation of flooding. He will campaign for this money to be allocated across the board to other areas that suffer with flooding.

These events will take place in late February at various locations which will be open to the public between 13.00 – 20.00 during which Highway England Staff will be available for people to talk to and ask questions. The nearest event for this parish is on:

## **Message from the Chairman of the Parish Council Doug Lowe.**

I thought it would be good to highlight some information for parishioners.

I think we must all thank everyone who helped on the weekend of the 5th to 8th February with the flooding in the Parish with their time spent on protecting the parish.

The Parish council will be arranging a meeting with all the agencies involved to see what more can be done to protect Ruishton. There was no flooding in Lower Henlade, so the work SCC did last year has helped. At the moment "Operation Gannex" flood team in Ruishton are short of people to help..... could you?

Highways England are planning several public information events along the A303/A358 corridor in late February to raise awareness of their plans for the route and provide local stakeholders and communities with an opportunity to give their initial feedback. These information events will also lay the foundations for future consultations on the three major improvements that we are developing for the route.

They will be holding a series of events on the following dates at these local venues:

25 February 2016 – The Monks Yard, Ilminster

26 February 2016 – Creative Innovation Centre CIC Taunton and at Tesco Superstore, Castle Street, Taunton.

The events will be open to the public from 13:00 until 20:00 during which Highways England staff will be available for people to talk to and ask questions.

We have asked our County Councillor Ross Henley to see if we could get some improvements to Ruishton Lane under small schemes, Mike Marshall and myself walked the road with him to point out the problems and dangers faced by pedestrians along the road. With increased traffic using Ruishton Lane to get onto the A358 we wish to make it safer for all users.

We have also asked Ross to arrange some speed checks on roads around the school which would be the start of the process to introducing a 20mph zone. Depending on the results Somerset County Council highways would consider it and ask the police traffic team for comments.

At our last Parish council meeting Ross was going to try to get a grant so the parish council could run a First Aid course in the village through St Johns Ambulance.

As you may have seen in the newsletter last month the Parish Council believes it would be of benefit to the community of Ruishton, Henlade and Thornfalcon to produce our own Neighbourhood Plan. We have had some offers of help and are seeking others to contribute. Change is inevitable with the improvements to the A358 and further pressure for houses.

What benefits to the community do we want to see in the next 20 years; more play-space, walking and cycling routes, shops, school/nursery provision, community buildings, allotments, homes for local people? Unless we take the initiative change will be imposed on us as has happened elsewhere in Taunton Deane.

The Neighbourhood Plan is the way in which we can influence our community's future.
