RUISHTON AND THORNFALCON PARISH COUNCIL

At the last Council meeting held on 2nd March 2016. John Williams gave a talk on the role and wider duties of the Borough Council. Also the role and duties of Borough Councillors which is mainly to represent their Ward's interest and help constituents with their enquiries. John Williams answered questions from the Cllrs.

For some time, the Council has been very concerned in the lack of security at the Park and Ride site. Then in February the site suffered another unauthorised encampment by travellers. County Councillor Ross Henley has asked the following questions at the Somerset County Council Full Council meeting:

- 1 How much has been spent in legal costs to date on the various invasions
- 2 What security measures will the council take to make this more difficult to invade the site in future
- 3 What are the usage and income figures on days the site has been invaded

County Councillor Ross Henley will report back to the Council when he has received the answers

FLOODING

The Chairman and Vice Chairman had a meeting with representatives from Wessex Water, Somerset County Council, Environmental Agency and Taunton Deane Borough Council in regard to preventing flooding in the parish. Topics discussed were problems in Goosey Lane, floodgates at Dinhams Bungalows, the Ring Bank and the village pump opposite the Village Hall.

In regard to the village pump SCC will replace the village pump and it has been established that it is TDBC's role to maintain the pump. SCC will fit a new "intelligent" pump but cannot at present as it needs to be fitted to an electrical 3 phase system which TDBC need to put in place. However, this must be done before the end of March or the £20,000 from SCC's budget will be withdrawn. John Williams was asked if he could ensure that this work is carried out without delay.

A full report can be seen in March 2016 minutes on the web site. The Council has invited the above agencies at the Annual Parish Meeting to give the parishes an update and to answer resident's questions

NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING

The Steering Committee had a meeting with Jane Birch of Community Council for Somerset. The first steps are to obtain quotes for surveys and send letter to village organisations to ask them to nominate a representative to serve on the Steering Group. CCS will help to source the funding for the NP. At the last meeting the Council formally resolved to register our intention to Taunton Deane Borough Council to produce a Neighbourhood Plan.

However, there is still a requirement for further resident volunteers. The Council would like to ask if you would be willing to be a member of a Steering Committee – we do need a number of residents to put themselves forward to share the workload. For more information about Neighbourhood Planning for Ruishton & Thornfalcon, please look on the website at the address below. If you are interested in helping, please contact the Clerk on the email address/ phone no. below. An update of the Neighbourhood Plan will be a standard item on future Council agendas.

ELECTORAL REVIEW

Cllrs Lowe, Marshall and Bulgin attended a meeting at TDBC on a briefing in regard to Electoral Reviews of the boundaries of District Council Wards within the local authority and if they need to be altered.

The reviews aim is to ensure fairer representation at local government elections and to deliver a pattern of wards where each councillor represents approximately the same number of electors. Creech St Michael and Ruishton has 12% more electors per District Council than average. There are two key dates:

Public Consultation on new ward boundaries – 28.6.16 to 5.9.16

Draft recommendations from public consultation – 8.11.16 to 9.1.17

ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY

The Annual Parish Assembly will be held on 21st April 2016 at 7.00pm in the Village Hall. The purpose of the Assembly is to enable the registered electors to discuss parish affairs. The meeting is also an opportunity for the Parish Council to report on the activities over the last year. An elector may ask questions, comments on parish issues and propose and vote on resolutions. This year there will be further topics on flooding and future short, medium and long term objectives to ensure the Parish Council is proactive. Any ideas or wishes from the residents will be welcomed.
