## **RUISHTON AND THORNFALCON PARISH COUNCIL**

### **CASUAL VACANCY**

### **ANNUAL PARISH MEETING**

The Annual Parish Assembly was held on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2016 at 7.00pm in the Village Hall. In attendance this year were representatives from Somerset Highways, Somerset County Council and the Environment Agency mainly to report on flooding issues in the parish. The Meeting found this information very valuable and useful as we received the latest information on issues in the parish and what the different Agencies can and cannot do.

### **MAY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING**

Cllr Doug Lowe was re-elected as Chairman, and Cllr Mike Marshall was re-elected as Vice Chairman. Other Councillors were appointed specific areas of responsibility which can be seen on the Council's website.

### **SOMERSET HIGHWAYS MAINTENANCE INFORMATION**

Grass Cutting – Highway verges are cut to a minimum of one metre in width from the road side. Sight lines are also cut at road junctions and bends to ensure better visibility for road users and pedestrians. Each highway verge and junctions will be cut once during the season except A and B road junctions visibilities which will be cut twice.

Grass cutting programme is:

A & B roads (including visibility splays) 16 May – 10 June

C and unclassified roads 13 June – 5 August

A & B visibility splays only Mid to late August

Weed spraying – Under the Noxious Weed Act 1959, certain noxious weeds, including ragwort must be removed where they are reported as causing a nuisance to highway users and adjoining landowners. Other invasive species treated and controlled by the County Council are Japanese Knotweed, Himalayan Knotweed, Himalayan Balsam and Giant Hogweed.

Hedges – The majority of hedges bordering the highway are privately owned. Landowners and occupiers are responsible for the maintenance of their boundary to make sure their hedge, tree or shrub does not obstruct the highway user or lines of sight at junctions. When hedges or other vegetation overhangs the highway, pedestrians can injure themselves from the impact with the vegetation and alternatively, pedestrians can be forced towards the carriageway, which can result in an increased risk of an accident. Land owners must also remove any debris from the road surface to prevent nuisance and to stop it blocking surface water drainage systems. However please note that the bird nesting season is between 1 March and 31 July.

Parking on pavement and verges – The Parish Council would like to add that vehicles inconsiderately parked with one side on the pavement or verge can force pedestrians, especially with pushchairs or disabled buggy users, towards the carriageway, which can result in an increased risk of an accident. It has been reported to the Council that vehicles have been parking on the pavement at Lawn Meadow

### **PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY IN THE PARISH**

It has come to the Council's attention that walkers, especially dog walkers, are straying from the dedicated Public Rights of Way and are actually trespassing in farmer's fields. Farmers are concerned as in this present climate of TB, that TB could be spread to livestock, also the possibility of gates are not fastened securely. There are Public Rights of Way maps for Ruishton & Thornfalcon posted on the notice board in Ruishton at the bus stop by Dinham's car-park and on the notice board at the Post Office.

### **BUS TIMES ON THE A358 .**

For those of you who catch buses on the main A358 the bus times have changed. The Webber buses are no longer trading but First are now running a 55 bus service to Wells. The times of the 54 and 55 are given below:

The 54 leaves Henlade going to Taunton every hour at 8.00, then at 8 minutes pass the hour from 10.08 to 20.08.

The 55 leaves Henlade going to Taunton every hour at 8.38, then at 38 minutes pass the hour from 9.38 to 20.38.

The 54 leaves Taunton at 6.14am then every hour at 14 minutes past the hour until 18.14 it gets to Henlade at 6.28 and every hour at 28 minutes past the hour. These buses go onto Yeovil.

The 55 leaves Taunton at 6.44am then every hour at 44 minutes past the hour until 17.44 it gets to Henlade at 6.58 and every hour at 58 minutes past the hour. These buses go onto Wells.

None of these buses now goes up to the hospital. You need to change at the bus station onto a no. 9
