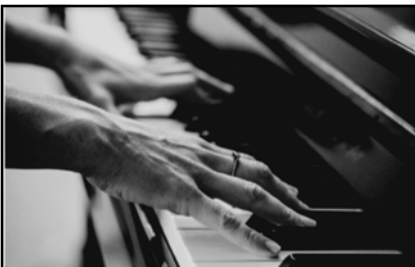

RUISHTON AND THORNFALCON PARISH COUNCIL

A358 TAUNTON TO SOUTHFIELDS SUPPLEMENTARY CONSULTATION

The background to this is that the original consultation asked people views in relation to their proposals to the upgrade of the A358. To help the analysis of the consultation responses, Highways England split the proposal into two sections. Section 1 was the improvement from the M5 to a proposed junction (junction B) in the vicinity of West Hatch Lane. Section 2 covered the improvement from the proposed junction B in the vicinity of West Hatch Lane to Southfields Roundabout. Highway England has proposed a supplementary consultation with regard to Section 1 with more options as only one option was offered in the original consultation.

The supplementary consultation will be launched and completed this calendar year and will be supported by a series of public exhibitions. One public exhibition will be held on Wednesday 15 November between 4pm and 7pm in Ruishton Village Hall. After the public exhibition at around 7pm, Highway England will stay for a special meeting of the Parish Council where they will present the options and answer any questions from the public.

Please make a note of the public exhibition and presentation in your diary and do make the effort to come along, as the route options could affect the parish or residents individually.

DEFIBRILLATOR IN THE VILLAGE

The Parish Council has applied for a grant from Somerset Community Foundation. If awarded, the grant will only fund part of the defibrillator costs and the Council will raise further funds from the precept and donations. The defibrillator will be purchased from Heartstart and positioned at the Village Hall. OVERGROWN VEGETATION

Somerset Highways undertakes highway management throughout the County. One of their duties is to maintain highways as a safe environment for all road users. When hedges tree or shrub overhangs the highway, pedestrians can injure themselves from the impact with the vegetation and alternatively, pedestrians can be forced towards the carriageway, which can result in an increased risk of an accident. Responsibility for cutting back vegetation lies with the landowners or occupiers of their boundary fronting the highway. The Parish Council's responsibility is to report such matters to Somerset Highways.

Please can you check if any of your boundaries with the highway has offending growth and, if it

has, make arrangements to remove any overgrown vegetation Land owners must also remove any debris from the road surface to prevent nuisance and to stop it blocking surface water drainage systems.

Countryside lovers are being invited to step forward and help protect and maintain Somerset's public rights of way which is in excess of 6000km (3,728 miles) through the 'Adopt a Path' scheme.

Walkers, cyclists and horse riders can help support Somerset County Council's Rights of Way team when they are out and about on their favourite Public Footpaths, Public Bridleways, Restricted Byways and Byways Open to All Traffic (BOAT).

Volunteers are invited to 'Adopt a Path' to report back any issues such as overgrown stiles or gates, missing or overgrown signposts or waymarks and overgrown vegetation. Most importantly these volunteers assist a step further by helping to keep pinch points, signs, stiles and gates vegetation free.

In return, Somerset County Council will provide help and advice, cover under their insurance policy, and can provide secateurs and gloves to help volunteers maintain paths in tip top condition for all to enjoy.

Deputy Leader of the Council, Councillor David Hall, said: "A huge thank you to the many volunteers who already Adopt a Path throughout Somerset. The paths available for adoption cross the open hills on the Mendips, Quantocks and Blackdowns and the lowlands on the Somerset Levels, through woodlands and along beaches providing a wide range of views and experiences – some of the most beautiful parts of Somerset.

"Applying to Adopt a Path couldn't be easier. Apply online or contact us direct and we can then discuss which area or parish you'd like to adopt within.

The scheme is open to everyone, with under 18s welcome to participate along with a parent or guardian.
