

M5 Junction 25 Improvement Scheme

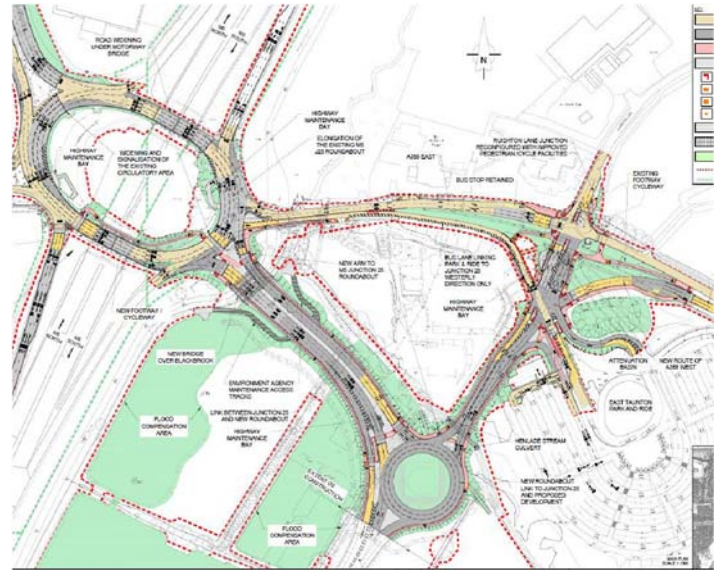

UPDATE

This is a short update on progress at Junction 25. We're pleased to confirm the important planning and site preparation works are now largely complete and we're moving on to the main construction programme. This means you will start to see more activity on site around Junction 25 from next week, although this will continue to be offline with no immediate impact on traffic.

The next phases of work will include establishment of site boundaries, earthworks near the Gateway Park & Ride, and removal of asbestos from the Cambria Farm buildings. We'll also be diverting the bridleway near Cambria Farm and preparing to drill trial holes and start work on widening the gyratory around the Junction 25 roundabout.
