Prizes – 1st £25, 2nd £15 and 3rd £10. A trophy and rosette will also be awarded to the winner; rosettes will be awarded for second and third. The trophy is to be held by the winner for one year.

Buckets in Bloom – a planted up bucket

Brighten up our neighbourhood! Put your potato-growing bucket to good use this year by planting up growing plants for visual effect! Bucket size: maximum diameter approx. 13”(33 cm), volume not to exceed 3 gallons (approx. 14 litres).

Buckets in Bloom to be displayed near the pavement/ edge of road for judging on Sunday 10th July from 10am, and left on show until at least Saturday 16th July.

These will be judged by the flower shower committee on Sunday 10th July.

Prizes – 1st £15, 2nd £10 and 3rd £5.
